

A Lancashire Linus pattern

Fun Fast Fat Quarter Quilt

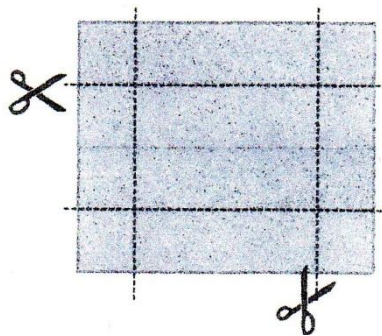
A quick quilt for using up a stash of fat quarters – Yes, all those packs of fat quarters bought at the shows!! The quilt can be enlarged by using more fat quarters or by adding borders.

You will need:

4 x fat quarters – baby, toddler, themed eg music, black and white, floral etc

Method:

1. Layer up the FQ's right side up, smallest on the top – press each one as you add it to the stack.
2. Trim the stack to the smallest FQ.
(minimum = 18" x 20"/ maximum 20" x 22")
3. Leave the stack in place and cut 5" strips from the 4 sides



4. Take out the middle stack and lay the pieces out on the table – to each centre, add sides, corners, top and bottom – mixing up the fabrics.
5. You now have 4 x 9 patch blocks. Sew up using 1/4" seam allowance.
6. Press and then sew blocks into a 4 patch.
7. The quilt top is complete. Back, quilt and bind it.
