## Fun Fast Fat Quarter Quilt

A quick quilt for using up a stash of fat quarters - Yes, all those packs of fat quarters bought at the shows!! The quilt can be enlarged by using more fat quarters or by adding borders.

You will need:
4 x fat quarters - baby, toddler, themed eg music, black and white, floral etc
Method:

1. Layer up the FQ's right side up, smallest on the top - press each one as you add it to the stack.
2. Trim the stack to the smallest FQ.
(minimum $=18^{\prime \prime} \times 20^{\prime \prime} /$ maximum $20^{\prime \prime} \times 22^{\prime \prime}$ )
3. Leave the stack in place and cut $5^{\prime \prime}$ strips from the 4 sides

4. Take out the middle stack and lay the pieces out on the table - to each centre, add sides, corners, top and bottom - mixing up the fabrics.
5. You now have $4 \times 9$ patch blocks. Sew up using $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance.
6. Press and then sew blocks into a 4 patch.
7. The quilt top is complete. Back, quilt and bind it.
