Poor Man's Pineapple

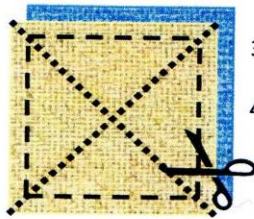
A simple block made from squares.

Choose a light and dark fabric for best contrast.

When making a quilt with two colours only – remember to alternate centre square colour.

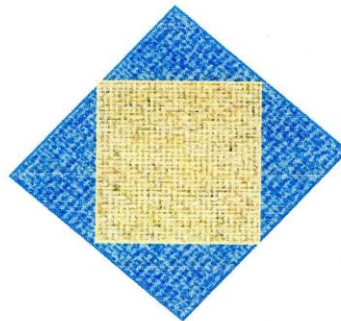
Method:

1. Cut two squares of contrasting fabric any size (4" – 5" – 6")
2. On wrong side of fabric to be cut (i.e. not centre square) draw diagonal lines. RS together.



3. Sew all around the square
4. Slide scissors between the fabrics and cut on the diagonal lines

5. Open and press out



6. Measure for the next square to be cut
7. Draw diagonal lines on the WS. Repeat steps 3 onward.....
