## SCRAP QUILT 2.



This patchwork quilt can be made in any size. Sort out scrap fabrics into lights and darks. You can have a theme: e.g. autumn colours, stars, farm animals etc. Cut fabric pieces to measure 3.5 inches $\times 2$ inches.
Use $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seams and hand or machine stitch pieces together into blocks as follows:

| Dark | Light |

Make equal quantities of each of these blocks.
Stitch these small blocks into strips and join as shown below:

Continue until you reach the required size and then layer with wadding and backing, quilt and bind.
